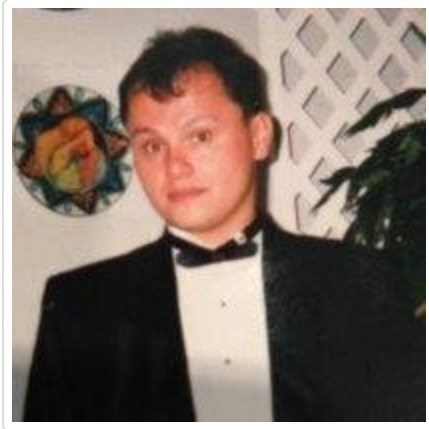




Christopher Lee McCuller
