Gary Lanier, born in Alexandria, LA on July 9, 1943, found his resting place in Glory on January 25, 2022.

Gary is a prolific composer, arranger, songwriter and orchestrator with over 10,000 published works including adult musicals, youth musicals, children's musicals, choral collections octavos, solos, worship choruses, orchestrations, and instrumental music ranging from classical to contemporary styles. His music is being sung and played around the world.

His Graveside Service will be on Tuesday, February 8, 2022, 2:00 p.m. at Edgewood Cemetery, Lancaster, Texas. Grave side service will be open to the public.

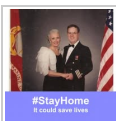
