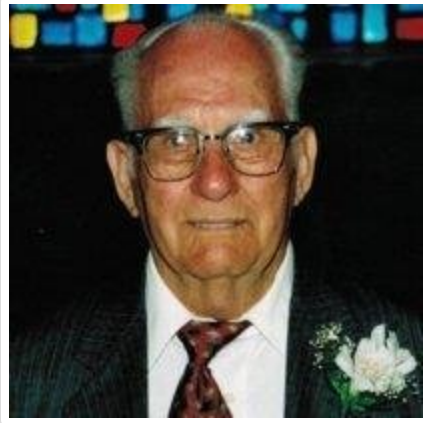




John Lewis Loyd III
